**Case Details:**

Victim Banwari Lal, age 38, is a resident of Ardana Village, Atru, Kota.

On 28 October 2007 at 8.30pm, a police jeep arrived at Banwari Lal's house. SIs Chauthmal and Jugal Kishore got out and asked him where his brother Hemraj Meena was. Banwari Lal replied that Hemraj Meena was inside. The SIs went inside and told Hemraj Meena that Sarpanch had called him, before beating him, pushing him outside, forcing him into the jeep, and taking him to the Atru PS.

Eight people, including Banwari Lal and Radhey Shyam, travelled by bike to the station, but Hemraj Meena was not there. The eight people looked for him at the Chowki, but did not find him there. They called Sarpanch Krishna Kumari Dilawar, who said that he would come in the morning.

At around 10.00pm, Banwari Lal and his companions returned to the station. Just then, the jeep arrived, but only SI Chauthmal was inside. The SI told them that Hemraj Meena would come soon, and then went inside to change his clothes.

After 20 minutes, the SI returned and told them that Hemraj Meena was in the Chowki, but that he had fallen from the jeep, injured his stomach, and been taken to the hospital.

The SI took Radhey Shyam to the hospital, where the latter learned that Hemraj Meena's condition was deteriorating. Radhey Shyam called Banwari Lal and told him the news. Banwari Lal and the others arrived and saw that Hemraj Meena was taken to Baran.

SI Jugal Kishore told Banwari Lal that Hemraj Meena had tried to jump from the moving jeep and had injured his head.

Banwari Lal, Radhey Shyam, and the others went to Baran, where they saw that Hemraj Meena was taken to Kota in an ambulance. Banwari Lal spoke with Sarpanch Krishna Kumari Dilawar, who said that he would ruin the whole family.

Banwari Lal, Radhey Shyam, and the others went in a jeep to Kota, where they had Hemraj Meena admitted to the MBS Hospital.

On 29 October 2007, Hemraj Meena's health degraded further.

On 30 October 2007 at 4.00am, Hemraj Meena died. Banwari Lal and the others fled.

Later, Banwari Lal was not allowed to get near Hemraj Meena's body or to talk to the doctors. When he and the others finally succeeded, they saw injury marks all over Hemraj Meena's body, especially on his back, hands, and legs.

After a post-mortem examination, Banwari Lal and the others retrieved Hemraj Meena's body. They, with Asesmbly Member Pramod Thapa, ex-Assembly Member Shiv Narayan Nagar, ex-District Chief Bharat Charan, and other important people from Meena put the body on the road and demanded compensation and the filing of a case against the police. District Collector Baran Sr. Pritam, Yashwant, and SP Ranjeet Singh arrived and ordered that a murder case be filed u/s 302 IPC against Sarpanch Krishna Kumari Dilawar.

At 4.45pm, the demonstrators took Hemraj Meena's body away and cremated it.

Banwari Lal later learned that the police had allegedly beaten Hemraj Meena almost to death after taking him to the forest on the orders of Sarpanch Krishna Kumari Dilawar. These orders allegedly followed a meeting on 27 October 2007 at which the beating was planned.

#### Case Details:

Bhagchand Kahar lived in Christian Ganj, Ajmer and lived with his wife Meera, son Pappu, and grandson. On 27 July 2006, a PC went to Bhagchand's house and arrested him. Bhagchand was accused in a theft case in 1996 and obtained bail, but his advocate Ashok Mehra neglected to notify Bhagchand that his bail period expired. When Bhagchand failed to appear in court, he was arrested. The PC told Meera that Bhagchand could be released on bail. For two days, Meera and Pappu searched for Bhagchand at PSs, but could not locate him.

On 5 August 2006, the PC met Pappu and told him that Bhagchand was in jail. The PC told Pappu to have Bhagchand released on bail. On 6 August 2006, Pappu and Meera went and met Baghchand in the jail. Bhagchand told them to apply for bail when he was produced

at court on 10 August 2006. Before he was arrested, Bhagchand was very healthy, but at the jail Bhagchand was weak and his face was swollen.

On 7 August 2006, Bhagchand fainted in jail and was admitted in JLN hospital for treatment. At 7.30pm, Pappu went to the hospital and unsuccessfully searched for Bhagchand. Pappu returned home at 11.00pm. At about 3.00am on 8 August 2006, the same PC went to Bhagchand's house and informed that Bhagchand died in the hospital. The PC took Pappu's signature on a piece of paper, the contents of which he did not understand. When Pappu went to the hospital with his uncles to collect the body, the doctors told them that Bhagchand was dead when he was brought to the hospital.

#### Case Details:

Victim Bharat Kumar was a resident of Kotari village, Chhabra Tehsil, Baran District. He was a tuberculosis patient.

On 29 August 2005, the ADJ Court of Chhabara sentenced Bharat Kumar to life imprisonment for murdering his son.

On 9 October 2005, Bharat Kumar was transferred to the Ajmer Central Jail, where the jail staff assert that he underwent medical treatment by jail doctors.

Sometime before 7 October 2007, Bharat Kumar fell ill; the jail staff did not immediately have him admitted to a hospital.

On 7 October 2007, Bharat Kumar was admitted to the JLN Hospital.

On 13 October 2007, Bharat Kumar died. An investigation was filed u/s 176 Cr.P.C. and delegated to the ADM.

Bharat Kumar's body was handed over to his family after a post-mortem examination. His family took the body to Chhabra.

The exact cause and circumstances of Bharat Kumar's death, and of his delayed admission to the Hospital, remain unclear.

**Case Details:**

Victim Daya Ram is a shop owner in Kanwas village. He bought a jeep from Narendra Singh of Rupaheda village for Rs. 2 lakhs, but paid only Rs. 40,000. Daya promised to pay the balance on 10 January 2007. Since Narendra did not receive his money, he went to the PS to complain about Daya. The police told Narendra that if he registered a case of recovery, it would be a civil case and that the police could not take any action. They suggested Narendra file a theft case against Daya to ensure speedy recovery of money. Narendra filed the complaint for theft.

On 12 January 2007, POs went to Daya's shop and arrested him for theft. At the PS, the POs interrogated Daya about the jeep and beat him. According to Daya's father Mohan Lala, the POs killed Daya during police torture and threw his body on the railway track. The railway police recovered the body, but could not identify it. Mohan Lal went to Bhawani Mandi on 14 January 2007, when he learned that Daya was dead.

However, the police allege that Daya told them he sold the jeep to Pawan, and the POs took Daya to Bhawani Mandi Railway Station to collect the money from Pawan. Then, while Daya was waiting with ASI Ganshyam Godham, PC Sahi Ram, PC Rek Raj, PC Murari Lal and Narendra, Daya jumped before a passing train and committed suicide.

Daya's body was kept at the Railway hospital mortuary. A postmortem was conducted the next day.

**CASE DETAILS:**

Victim Raghunath Prasad Mathuralal, age 63, was sentenced to life imprisonment in Kota Central Jail.

Mathuralal fell ill in jail and was admitted to MBS Hospital. Mathuralal was admitted under critical condition.

On 21 October 2007, Mathuralal died in MSB Hospital. While jailor Gobind Singh claims that Mathuralal died because of tuberculosis, Mathuralal's medical records do not disclose the reason for his death. Mathuralal's family believes he died because of torture in the Kota Central Jail.

Victim Kamal Kishore Panchal aged 35 years lived in Kal Puriya Basti. Kamal was an auto rickshaw driver but was addicted to alcohol and drugs. He was then sent to a de-addiction center for treatment, but ran away. On 5 April 2007 he was arrested by the Nayapura police. Although his health was poor, Kamal was kept in jail. On 15 April 2007, he was admitted at MBS hospital for treatment. On 30 April 2007, Kamal died at the hospital.

Karan Singh Yadav, age 20 years, was imprisoned for the murder Pappu Singh. He was transferred to the Jodhpur Central Jail on 16 April 2007. On 25 April 2007, Karan's dead body was found hanging from a window rod in the toilet. The judicial inquired into the case, but many questions remained unanswered.

**Case Details:**

Mohammad Islam was imprisoned at Jodhpur Central Jail.

On 5 April 2007, Jodhpur Central Jail Jailor Bharat Bhushan, Chief Warden Kanjaiya, and three other Jodhpur Central Jail employees beat Islam as he was being transferred from to a different ward. Islam was screaming in pain from the beatings.

Islam died in custody soon after. Islam's post mortem indicated that he had twenty-four cuts on his body and a broken rib.

Jail officials did not inform Islam's family about his death. The family learned of Islam's death a month after it occurred when Islam's body was delivered to their house from the mortuary.

**Case Details:**

Victim Prehlad, age 50, lived in Choti village before being imprisoned for life in Kota Central Jail.

While in custody, Prehlad was admitted to MBS Government Hospital between 30 June 2006 and 8 September 2006. He was diagnosed with cervical myopia and was given treatment.

After he returned to jail, Prehlad's health did not improve, and he was unable to eat or drink adequately. He made several requests to the jail authorities for more medical treatment but was ignored.

On 14 June 2007, Prehlad was discovered dead in his cell. His body was taken to MBS Government Hospital where the post mortem examination was conducted. The hospital authorities made Prehlad's family sign documents stating that Prehlad died after reaching the hospital.

**Case Details:**

Victim Shyog Raj was serving a life sentence at Amjr Jail, where SHO Ramchandra and Jailor Prita Bhargav worked.

Raj was housed in a barrack with a prisoner named Mangilal who was suffering from a mental disorder, and who was serving a life sentence for stoning his family to death. Raj and other prisoners had previously lodged complaints with the Jail Superintendent regarding Mangilal's behavior, but no measures were taken.

On 9 November 2007, while Raj was sleeping, Manjilal killed Rak by throwing a heavy stone on him. Raj died on the spot.

**Case Details:**

Victim Hemraj, age 30, and his mother victim Umrao Devi, age 55, are residents of Kamla Nehru Nagar, Jodhpur.

On 28 August 2007 at midnight, between fifty and sixty Excise Officers in civilian clothing – led by CI Pratap Ram, CI Pratap Singh, PC Manoharlal Vishnoi, and SI Ramkisan Daya – barged into Umrao Devi's house with no search warrant, carrying sticks and rods. Umrao Devi was not home at the time. The police broke the front iron gate of her door and opened the latch, which

was locked from the inside, before searching her house. They opened the almirah in the wall. They searched Hemraj's room while they were sleeping, before beating Hemraj and taking him to the police station.

At the station, the police filed a false case against Hemraj, saying that they had found five illegal liquor bottles during their search. They put Hemraj in the lock-up.

The next day, the police produced Heraj before the court, which released him.

When Umrao Devi returned home and learned what had happened, she checked the almirah and found that Rs. 2,000, as well as a silver purse, a silver ring, and gold rings were missing.

Umrao Devi went to the station and demanded the return of her property, but the police refused. The police threatened to molest her and to arrest Hemraj on a false case if she proceeded against them.

Umrao Devi's neighbours are aware of the incident, but are too frightened to testify.

Umrao Devi filed a complaint in court. No action was taken.

#### Case Details:

Victim Rajendra Singh, age 40, and victim Mukesh Saxena, age 45, are both residents of Rishkesh Nagar Nagaur Road, Jodhpur.

On 14 June 2006, when Rajendra Singh was in court, he learned from labour union leaders Om Singh Bhayal, Prem Chowdry, and Shakeel Khoker, and from Mukesh Saxena, that cabins and thetas were being removed, and goods seized, by the police. Rajendra Singh and the union leaders rushed to the Olympic Chowraha, where hundreds of hawkers and many members of the public were present.

Rajendra Singh went to the Municipal Commissioner to enquire about the incident. The Commissioner did not provide a satisfactory reply.

At the same time, CI Chain Singh Mahecha, outraged, approached Rajendra Singh. The CI grabbed Rajendra Singh's collar and dragged him towards a police van. Between fifteen and twenty officers assisted the CI in pushing Rajendra Singh forcefully into the van.

Rajendra Singh and Mukesh Saxena were taken to the Sadapura PS. There, PC Narendra Kumar Singh took all of the money from Rajendra Singh's pocket. Rajendra Singh and Mukesh Saxena were kept in the lock-up for two hours.

Around four hundred members of the public opposed the police action, so the police shifted Rajendra Singh and Mukesh Saxena to Shastri Nagar PS.

At 2.30pm, after further public pressure, the police released Rajendra Singh and Mukesh Saxena.

The police have since filed a false case against Rajendra Singh.

#### Case Details:

Victim Prahlad Singh is a farmer and labourer. Singh had a land dispute with Ganj PS police officer Tejsingh. Consequently, police officer Tejsingh, along with Mangliyawas PS ASI Rampal Visnoi, conspired to trap Singh with false charges.

On 29 October 2007, at around 6:00am, some police officers arrived at Singh's farm and charged him with murder. The police officers pulled Singh's wife's clothes off, pulled her hair, and touched her in inappropriate ways. The police officers also kicked and punched Singh. The police officers took Singh and his wife to Mangliyawas PS.

At the Mangliyawas PS, the police officers again behaved inappropriately with Singh's wife, and beat Singh. The police officers demanded a bribe of Rs. 20,000 in exchange for dropping the false charges. The police officers also forced Singh to sign a blank paper by threatening to imprison him for life under murder and theft charges.

The police officers detained Singh and his wife for 23 hours.

**Case Details:**

Victim Rakesh Berwa had a rent dispute with his landlord, who had influence over Madanganj PS police officers.

Consequently, on 5 June 2007, Mandanganj PS Constable Nand Kishore, Constable Kuldeep Singh, and Constable Rajendra Singh arrested Berwa under the false charge of committing a crime while intoxicated. Berwa was ultimately exonerated.

Berwa then filed a complaint against the officers for filing the false case against him. The police officers threatened to hurt Berwa if he did not withdraw the complaint, and also offered him bribes. The officers were found guilty of filing a malicious case against Berwa.

### Case Details:

Victim Adidan Ram Megwal, age 60, is a resident of Vill Mothen, Phalodi. He is a farmer. He had a dispute with other villagers about his land, as a result of which the villagers damaged one of his huts, causing damage amounting to Rs. 50,000-60,000.

On 20 September 2007, Adidan Ram Megwal came to the Phalodi PS to lodge an FIR regarding damage to a hut on his land. When he entered the station, some officers confronted him and insulted his caste, demanding to know why he had come. When Adidan Ram Megwal replied, the policemen pushed him and he fell down. Adidan Ram Megwal left the station.

Later, Adidan Ram Megwal dragged an application and returned to the station, where he met the ASI and submitted his application. The ASI came with other officers to Adidan Ram Megwal's land, where they saw the damage. Instead of doing anything, the police demanded Rs. 1,000 from Adidan Ram Megwal as payment for hiring the jeep. Adidan Ram Megwal had only Rs. 500 in hand, which he gave to the police. Adidan Ram Megwal asked the officers to accompany him to the other villagers' residences, but they refused. They did, however, assure him that they would file his FIR.

The next day, Adidan Ram Megwal came to the station to collect a copy of his FIR, but the police asked him to return the next day.

A week passed after submission of Adidan Ram Megwal's complaint, and no action was taken.

### Case Details:

Victim Amrit Patel, age 40, is a resident of Chandraverdai Nagar, Ajmer District. He and his brother had rented some space from Devki Nandan for seventeen or eighteen years. They would pay their rent but did not collect receipts. At that property, they ran a shop where they cut wood for sale; Amrit Patel would often leave the city for business purposes.

On 2 July 2007, when the Amrit Patel was in Gujrat taking new orders, a relative called him to say that Devki Nandan had taken possession of his shop and property.

On returning to Ajmer, Amrit Patel spoke with Devki Nandan and asked why he had taken over the property. Devki Nandan replied that Amrit Patel owed him rent. Amrit Patel insisted that no rent was pending, but Amrit Patel began to abuse and fight with him.

On 4 July 2007, Amrit Patel went to Ramganj PS to submit a written complaint to ASI Girdhari Lal. The ASI asked him who his landlord was; Amrit Patel replied that it was Devki Nandan. The ASI cautioned him against acting, saying that Devki Nandan was very influential with the police. The ASI refused to register a complaint and asked Amrit Patel to leave. Amrit Patel explained that Devki had illegal possession of his shop and his property and requested that the ASI take all necessary action to restore his livelihood. The ASI threatened to put Amrit Patel in the lock-up. Amrit Patel departed.

Later, Amrit Patel returned to the station, where he saw Devki Nandan with the police. The ASI yelled at him for coming again and slapped him in front of Devki Nandan. The ASI made Amrit Patel sit in a corner for four hours while the police drank liquor with Devki Nandan.

On 20 July 2007, Amrit Patel submitted a typed complaint to the SP (Ajmer) to take legal action against Devki Nandan. No action was taken.

The police proceeded to call Amrit Patel often to the station, where they humiliated him and forced him to withdraw his complaint under threat of imprisonment.

**Case Details:**

Victim Deepak Vasvani, a 14 year old boy, was celebrating *holi* (festival of colors) with his friends Hemant, Bharat, Narendra, Jai Kishan, Satish and others. While they were playing, Deepak accidentally sprayed color on a home guard who passed by. The home guard was very angry that his clothes were spoilt and severely beat Deepak. Assembly Member Jasraj Sharma witnessed the beating. Assembly Member Sharma stopped the home guard and warned him that he would take severe action on him. Deepak's mother and took Deepak to the hospital where he was treated for 3-4 hours.

CI Amraram Vishnoi was on patrol in when he was notified of the incident. CI Vishnoi and the other PIs refused to accept the complaint.

**Case Details:**

Victim Jagdish Rawat ran a grocery store.

On 3 May 2007, Rawat was attacked by some people (hereinafter, "the attackers") while he was purchasing products for his store. The attackers rendered Rawat unconscious by striking him in the face with an empty bottle. The attackers also stole Rs. 2000 from Rawat.

The police were summoned but took no action. At the police station, the police officers refused to register a case against the attackers, with whom the police officers were drinking partners. Rawat has lodged complaints with the SP but no subsequent police action has been taken.

The attackers continue to threaten Rawat.

One of the police officers is a close relative of the village head. As a result, the police tried to pressure Raghuveer’s brother to withdraw the case

After the perpetrators left, Jalli was taken to Pushkar hospital. She was transferred to JLN hospital where she was treated for 20 days.

Ishwar attempted to lodge a complaint at the PS. However, POs refused to accept the complaint and told Ishwar not to return to the PS or they would make him drink urine.

While Jalli was unconscious in the hospital, ASI Phool Chand went and took her thumb prints on some papers. Moola saw ASI Phool Chand as he was leaving the ward.

In November 2001, Krishna Goyal filed a case u/s 498 IPC against her in-laws. Dinesh responded by filing a divorce case.

In April 2006, the divorce was denied; Krishna Goyal filed an appeal that is currently pending in the High Court, as is her case u/s 498 IPC. Meanwhile, Krishna Goyal was granted Rs. 3,000 maintenance.

Between July 2006 and September 2007, Dinesh regularly harassed Krishna Goyal; amongst other things, he broke her glasses, snatched her bag, threw her down, kicked her, and punched her.

On 29 September 2007, Krishna Goyal filed an incident report in the Udhyog Nagar Thana. However, Dinesh continued to harass Krishna Goyal through early October 2007.

On 5 October 2007, Krishna Goyal went to Bhanwas Thana, but the police refused to file her report.

On 22 October 2007, Krishna Goyal's father complained to the SP (village). Dinesh continued to harass and to hurt Krishna Goyal.

Krishna Goyal met the SP (city), but no action was taken.

On 20 August 2007, Mahendra brother beat him and Deep. Deep complained to the police, but no follow-up action was taken.

On 21 August 2007, the police arrested Mahendra on a false charge. On 23 August 2007, Mahendra was taken into judicial custody, and he was not provided food in jail. He was rendered unconscious due to hunger.

On 23 August 2007, Mahendra was sent to the central jail, where Deep was forced to pay the jail guard Rs. 5000.

That day, Gajendra and Guju were cutting the trees to use as fodder for their cattle. Makhan told them to stop because he needed the trimmings for his own cattle. Gajju became angry and attacked

Makhan with an axe. Makhan defended himself, but still suffered head injuries. Makhan was carrying Rs. 5000/-, which was stolen by Gajju.

With the help of his wife, Makhan went to Madar Chowki to file a police report. The Officer in Charge was reluctant to file the report. HC Raja Ram took Rs. 500/- from Makhan, telling him that he might need the money for his medical treatment. HC Ram then sent Makhan to JLN Hospital. When Makhan returned, HC Ram demanded Rs. 5000/- to file the report. Makhan made several repeated requests to file the report, after which the Officer in Charge agreed to file the report on the condition that Makhan would not mention the Rs. 500/- previously taken. However, Makhan refused. The PC then told Makhan to leave or he would be locked up.

The next day Makhan attempted to file a complaint, but the POs refused to accept it.

According to the POs, on the day of the incident, Gajju and Makhan both attempted to file a complaint. When he told them the police could not accept a complaint from both parties, Makhan and Gajju said they would mutually resolve it and left without filing the report.

Due to financial difficulties, Seema started living with her parents. Seema started selling vegetables to earn money. Rajesh Nowariya used to buy vegetables from Seema. Often Rajesh was intoxicated and boasted that he was a police informant and held the police in his hands.

On 27 October 2007 at about 8.00pm, Rajesh asked Seema for some vegetables. When she was weighing the vegetables, Rajesh attempted to rape her. When she opposed him, he hit her. Rajesh told her not to tell anyone about the incident or he would kill her and her children. Later, Rajesh went to Seema insisting that she should marry him. Rajesh broke down her door and vandalized her room.

Seema attempted to file a complaint at the Udhyog Nagar PS, but the police refused to accept it. On 14 November 2007, Seema successfully filed a complaint against Rajesh in the Udhyog Nagar PS under sections 452, 376, 354, 501, 384, 385, 379. However, the police have not taken any action to arrest Rajesh.

Out of fear, Seema was forced to leave her parent's home and can no longer earn money by selling vegetables.

Later, one of the attackers threatened to kill Om Prakash, but the police took no action in response to Om Prakash’s complaint. Again, on 29 November 2007, one of the attackers attempted to kill Om Prakash. The Dandiyawaas PS POs refused to register the case.

On 16<sup>th</sup> June, 2007, the victim Rajesh Kumar made a complaint at Udyog Nagar PS. But he was under the threat of the constable. To avoid further complications, he had bought the shop of the constable.

**Case Details:**

Victim E.R. Tirkey is a Station Master at the Rai Ka Bagh Railway Station.

On 17 May 2007 at 1.45pm, a BSF special train from Gorakhpur reached the Rai Ka Bagh Railway Station's Platform No 2, where it stopped for a lunch break. Unfortunately, Platform No. 2 did not have any facilities for meals, which annoyed the BSF soldiers. Some BSF soldiers approached E.R. Tirkey and asked him to move the train to Platform No. 1; however, Platform No. 1 was busy, so E.R. Tirkey could not do so.

BSF Officer Rastogi and his colleagues became angry. Officer Rastogi pointed his gun at E.R. Tirkey, who was startled, and begged to be given time to make some arrangements. E.R. Tirkey called Chief Officer Tarun Ji, but while he was talking another BSF Officer snapped the phone line. Two BSF Officers held E.R. Tirkey's hands and pushed him out of his office. Then the BSF personnel and took all the railway officers who were in the room – including Assistant Station Master A. Rathore, Shunting Masters Dhool Singh Bhati, Vishmprakash, and Ravikant Verma, and Chief Commercial Supervisor Arvind Mishra, among others – outside and made them stand in a queue. Seeing that the railway officers were queued up at gunpoint and surrounded by BSF soldiers, some bystanders were taken aback.

After a few minutes, the BSF soldiers sent the railway officers except E.R. Tirkey back into E.R. Tirkey's office and locked them inside. Two soldiers guarded the room.

Meanwhile, E.R. Tirkey was asked to stand in the sun with his hands raised. After approximately twenty minutes, he managed to call the police.

The GRP and RPF arrived and calmed the situation.

Later, one of the BSF soldiers apologised on all of their behalf to E.R. Tirkey.

The GRP and RPF, and BSF inquiry officers, promised to investigate the situation. No action was taken.

#### Case Details:

On 14 August 2007, Baab PS police officer arrested victims Chaganlal, Jasaram, Hariram and Omprakash without giving them a reason. At the Baab PS, the police officers told the four that they were arrested on suspicion of murder. The Baab PS police officers beat the four, and forced them to confess to the murder.

On 22 August 2007, the Baab PS police officers hung the four on two chairs and they were tied together for two hours. The Baab PS police officers beat them again and threatened to kill them. On 25 August 2007, two of the four were released.

In a separate incident, on 17 August 2007, SHO Ramchandsingh and other police officers came to victim Gangadevi's home and beat her. The police officers pressured Gagadevi to convince her husband and brother to confess to the commission of a murder case. The police officers told Gagadevi that her husband and brother would be killed if they did not confess. On 19 August 2007, Baab PS police officers ordered Gangadevi to the police station. She was beaten there, and detained overnight.

On 1 August 2007, Channu Khan's son Nasir went missing. On 2 August 2007, Channu went to the Sadar Kotwali PS with his son Sabeer to lodge a complaint. DYSP Sulesh Choudry, ASI

Jagdish Prasad, and SHO Sultan Khan told Channu that Nasir was wanted for eloping and marrying Reena, a politician's daughter, and that Reena's father had lodged a complaint against Nasir and Channu. The POs threaten Channu and used abusive languages. Channu suffered a heart attack at the PS. Instead of the POs taking Channu to the hospital, Channu's daughter Suraiya admitted him to the Mathuradas Mathur Hospital.

Sabeer was put in lock-up and interrogated all night. The police refused to give him food, and instead required his family to bring him food. Sabeer vomited from hunger. Sabeer remained in lock-up until 6 August 2007. During that time, the police permitted him to take food only once every 24 hours. On 7 August 2007, Sabeer was released by order of the Magistrate.

On 3 August 2007, POs arrested Karan Singh and interrogated him about the location of Nasir. When Karan said he had no information, four POs beat him. DYSP Sulesh Chowdry beat him with stick until he was unconscious. When he regained consciousness, the POs beat him again. Karan was detained until 7 August 2007, and was provided no food during his incarceration.

#### Case Details:

Sharafat Ali had a dispute with an advocate and absconded from his village. The Dadwadi police were in search of him. Sharafat's brother-in-law Vikas Soni was at Sharafat's house visiting his sister Deepa, Sharafat's wife, on 5 June 2007. At that time POs came in search of Sharafat, and, when they did not find him, they arrested Vikas. At the PS POs interrogated Vikas about Sharafat's whereabouts. When Vikas was unable to give them any information, they beat him and put him in lock-up. A few hours later, Vikas was released on bail.

On 14 June 2007, Mahavir police went to Vikas' house and pulled him outside by his hair. He was arrested and taken to Mahavir PS. Vikas was released the next day. The POs took his mobile and refused to return it.

On 15 June 2007 at 5.00pm, Mahavir POs went to Deepa's house and asked her to come to the PS for an enquiry. Deepa refused and said she would answer any enquiry at her house. However, the POs forced Deepa and her children to go to the PS. At 8.00pm, Deepa was tied to a chair and beaten by CI Govind Singh and other policemen.

Deepa's mother learned of her arrest and later found her Mahavir PS. Vika's friend Ashu attempted to bring Deepa some food. Ashu found Deepa tied to a chair with her mouth gagged. The next day, Ashu returned to the PS with Deepa's mother. Deepa's children were handed over to Deepa's mother at 11.30am. Ashu saw Deepa when she came out to wash her hands; she appeared very badly beaten.

On 16 June 2007, Deepa was transferred to Vigyan Nagar PS where RPS Deepthi Agarwal and other policemen locked her in a cell and beat her face and back. Later during the day, SHO Hanuman Singh Nathawat went to the PS and saw Deepa in a critical condition. He ordered transferred from his station because the case was not under the jurisdiction of Vigyan Nagar PS.

Deepa was returned to Mahavir PS. On 17 June 2007, when her condition worsened, Deepa was released. Deepa's body was full blue patches from internal injuries. Deepa was unable to walk. She went up to the nearby telephone booth and called her mother. Immediately, Ashu and her mother rushed to telephone booth. They found her unconscious.

Deepa was taken to the government hospital where she narrated the episode to the media. Police from Vigyan Nagar PS learned about the disclosure, and went to the hospital. The POs threatened Deepa and forced the doctors to discharge her. Deepa was then treated by a private doctor.

In the jeep, SI Amaram Vishnoi and Rafik slapped Hanuman and abused them.

At the City PS, POs beat Hanuman and Lala. The POs interrogated Hanuman and Lala about different thefts. The police beat Hanuman, and then hung him from a rope all night. After Amaram and Rafik left, Hanuman asked Om Prakash to remove him from the rope so he could go to the toilet. Allegedly, Hanuman was so scared of the shame to his family, he attempted to commit suicide by drinking of bottle of acid that was kept in the PS toilet. Hanuman started vomiting and Om Prakash took him to Beawar hospital.

The media printed the story in the newspaper. On the 27 April 2007, when Hanuman's father heard about Hanuman, he died of heart attack. The POs approached Hanuman's brother and asked him not to file any case against them. The POs offered to compensate them for the cost of Hanuman's medical expenses. The POs gave Rs. 5000 and food worth Rs.2000 during the mourning ceremony of Hanuman's father. However, the POs did not pay for any of Hanuman's hospital expenses. Meanwhile, Hanuman's condition worsened, and he remains in critical condition.

Out of fear, Hanuman's brothers have not filed a case against the POs.

On 13 October 2007, the police returned Kalusingh to the Machiya Park Chowki, where he was beaten and forced to drink saltwater.

On 15 October 2007, the police produced Kalusingh before the Jodhpur Court, where he was bailed out.

The Forest Police have continued to harass Kalusingh.

The police then arrested Mangaram's descendents four times u/s 157, 107 IPC. Each time, the police detained them for twenty-four hours and made them stand half-naked.

On 15 March 2007 at about 6pm, police officers under the instructions of DYSP Dhampatrai Sankhla, CI Sant Kumar Yadav, SI Anwar Ali, and ASI Jaitaram Choudhary went to the village and honked their jeeps' horns. Suddenly, about ten to fifteen men armed with swords, knives, and sticks entered the victims' land and started to attack them.

The police witnessed this event and then arrested the victims. En route to the police station, the police let half of Mangaram's descendents go. The rest – including Jassraj, Dhanaram, Shivalal, and Shantilal – were brought to the station, and made to stand half-naked. They had injuries to their heads, backs, and shoulders.

When some female family members went to visit the detainees, they were arrested, while the other detainees were released. No medical examinations were performed on any of those detained.

From 15 March 2007 to 30 March 2007, the police guarded the disputed land, drove away Mangaram's descendents, and seized their household items (including gas stoves and beddings, worth about Rs 50,000).

On 28 March 2007, the victims staged a protest and submitted a petition to the Collector, IG, and CM. No action was taken.

The family currently has no place to stay.

On 15 December 2006, Dablana PS Constable Parmanand and other Darblana police officers arrested Rajput because he was accused of cheating two men (hereinafter, "the accusers") out of some money. The police officers took Rajput to the Dablana PS.

At the police station, the Darblana PS police officers, including ASI Omprakash and six others, severely beat Rajput. The accusers also beat him. Rajput was seriously injured as a result of the beatings and his face was heavily swollen. A case was filed against Rajput, and he was forced to sign a paper promising to pay Rs. 44,350 to the accusers. Rajput was detained until 17 December 2006.

A few days later the police apologized to Rajput and expressed that they were scared of losing their jobs as a result of their actions. The police officers gave a written pledge not to bother Rajput again.

#### Case Details:

Victim Nurool, age 32, lives in Bihar, but he often visits his relatives in Amjer.

On 2 April 2007, at around 11:30am, Nurool visited a sweet shop in Amjer where his friend worked. Nurool did not know that his friend had stolen Rs. 100,000 from the shop's owner the previous day. So, when Nurool asked the shop's owner about his friend's whereabouts, the shop owner in turn beat Nurool to learn where his friend might be.

At 12:00pm, Clock Tower PS police officers arrived at the shop and dragged Nurool by his hair to the police station. The police officers beat Nurool to extract information from him regarding his friend's whereabouts. Nurool had no information.

When the police learned that Nurool's brother's friend was the Chairperson of the National Congress Party, they released Nurool.

#### Case Details:

On 29 September 2007 at about 7.00pm, victim Rais Khan, a 19 year-old resident of Baap, Jodhpur, was returning home from work. As he was reaching his village, police officers, including Baap SHO Ram Chandra Rathore and four or five other PCs, stopped Rais. The POs beat Rais and then arrested him. Rais was taken to Baap PS and put in lock up. Later, Rais learned that he was arrested on allegations that he stole from Kailash Mali's shop.

At the Station, a senior officer asked why Rais was brought to the PS. SHO Ramchandra Rathore said that Rais was brought for inquiry and would be released soon. After the senior officer left, SHO Ramchandra Singh, constable Kishnaram and 2 or 3 other PC stripped Rais to his underwear and tied him up by his clothes. The POs beat Rais throughout the night. Rais was forced to spend the night without food and water. The police then filed charges against Rais.

**Case Details:**

Victim Ramchandra, age 36, is of the Vishnoi caste (Backward Caste). On 21 October 2007, Ramchandra was at a bus stand, returning from Jodpur, when Blaesar Pos in civilian clothing arrived and took him into custody. The police pulled Ramchandra into their jeep and beat him.

Later, the police told Ramchandra that he was arrested in connection with an attack on the Harman Rag family, which occurred while Ramchandra was in Jodpur. While in custody, the police beat Ramchandra with lathis and sticks on his hands and legs until they bled. Throughout the night, the police deprived Ramchandra of sleep.

On 23 October 2007, the police produced Ramchandra before the court.

**Case Details:**

On 14 August 2007 at around 2.00pm, SHO Ramchandra Singh Rathore, PC Bhanwarlal Jyani (vishnoi), PC Preamsingh Ravlot, Driver Harchandraram Bhambhu, and HPC Kishanaram Meghwal went to victim Ramachandra Nai's house. Ramachandra Nai was a 51 year-old resident of Sihera village, Phalandi, Jodhpur. The POs arrested Ramchandra Nai, Ramachandra Nai's son Chaganlal, his brother-in-law Hariram and his brother-in-law's son Omprakash. They were taken to Phalandi City and then to Baap PS. The victims were put in lock up. Later that night, SHO Ramchandra arrested Jasraj, and also brought him to the Baap PS. All the victims were stripped of their clothes, locked in a cell, and deprived of food and water.

On 15 August 2007, victims were told that they were arrested for murdering Uttam Singh. The POs asked victims to admit the crime. Because they had no connection to the murder they denied the charges. The entire day, the POs pressured victims to admit they were responsible for the murder. That night, the SHO beat all the victims until they were unconscious. Ramchandra Nai was hung upside down by a rope and beaten severely. The POs forced Ramchandra Nai to sip urine from a cup. That night, the police prohibited victims from sleeping by forcing them to run the whole night.

In the afternoon of 16 August 2007, Dhanpat Samkhla and some PCs interrogated victims again. That night, the SHO beat Ramachandra and his son with a belt for an hour. Then all victims were again deprived of sleep and forced to run all night.

On 17 August, SHO Ramchandra Singh and some PCs went to Ramchandra Nai's home and assaulted Ramchandra Nai's wife Ganga Devi. On 19 August police arrested Ganga Devi and took her to the PS. Male PCs and the SHO beat her and prohibited her from sleeping. She was released on 20 August and had to find her own way home.

On 21 August the police again beat the five victims, and forced them to run all night.

#### Case Details:

Salim Mohammed s/o Munir, age 30yrs is a Shiya Muslim. He is educated upto Calss VIII and works as a mechanic. He lives in a rented house in Narsingpura Ajmer road, Tehsil Beawar District with his wife. He earns about Rupees three thousand per month.

On 4 March 2007 at 7 a.m., he heard a knock at his door and someone answered Salim that it was the milkman. But Salim does not have a milkman coming home and therefore went to the door to check. When he opened the door there were six policemen in civilian clothes waiting for him. SI Likhma Ram, SI Aatma Ram, Constable Noor Mohammed, Constable Jagdish and two other constables were there. They enquired if he was Salim and then caught him by his shirt

collar, held his hands firmly, forcibly put him in the jeep and took him to city police station. On reaching the station they enquired about a stolen table fan.

Salim had bought a table fan a week ago from a stranger who said he was selling his fan as needed money urgently. Salim explained this to the police, but was in vain. They asked him where he had kept the fan and when he said that it was at his house, they brought him home and they took the fan and Salim back to the police station.

He was detained in the police station for five days. His hands were tied behind and he was hung face downwards. He was tied the same way everyday during the nights. SI Likhma Ram, SI Aatma Ram, Constable Noor Mohammed, Constable Jagdish used to beat him with belts and sticks every night. In addition to the physical torture, he was verbally abused. They often referred to his caste while scolding him. They have stated the all Muslim were thieves. He had also kept him hungry and thirsty all the five days.

From 4 March 2007 to 7 March 2007 he was illegally detained in the police station. On 7 March a false theft was implicated on him. When Salim wanted to go home and asked the policemen to release him, they threatened that they would implicate him in any non bailable offence, if he spoke anything more.

When Salim's wife came to see him in the police station, she was asked to give Rs. 2000 (Rupees Two thousand only). On 9 March 2007, SI Likhma Ram and Aatma Ram took Rs. 10000 (Rupees Ten thousand only) from Salim and released him. They said that they would jeopardized him if spoke about his detention to anybody.

On 11 March 2007, he went to Amrit Kaur Hospital in Beawar for treatment. The doctor enquired about the injuries and refused to give treatment on hearing that the injuries were due to police torture. So he went to the medical store and bought a pain killer to relieve himself from pain for a short while. Then he went to ayurveda hospital, but his pain persisted. So, Salim went back to Amrit Kaur hospital. He managed to get an O.P. (Out Patient) ticket and met Dr. Hemant Chauhan. The doctor asked his name and refused to treat him. He said that he would not treat someone who was caught in a theft case. Immediately he went to the telegraph office and sent a complaint to the collector regarding incident by 1.10 p.m. (telegraph number 19096).

### Case Details:

Victim Salim Mohammed, age 30 and a Muslim, is a mechanic and lives on Narsingpura Ajmer Road in Tehsil Beawar District.

On 4 March 2007, at 7:00am, six Beawar PS police officers came to Mohammed's door. Among the officers were SI Likhma Ram, SI Aatma Ram, Constable Noor Mohammed, Constable Jagdish and two other unnamed constables. The officers forcibly put Mohammed in their jeep and transported him to the Beawar PS. At the station, the officers questioned Mohammed about a stolen table fan.

Mohammed explained to the police that he bought the fan from a stranger who claimed he needed money urgently. Mohammed went with the police back to the house to retrieve the fan. They all then returned to the Beawar PS.

The officers detained Mohammed at the Beawar PS from 4 March 2007 through 7 March 2007. During that period, every night the police officers tied Mohammed's hands behind his back and hung him upside down. SI Likhma Ram, SI Aatma Ram, Constable Noor Mohammed, and Constable Jagdish beat Mohammed with belts and sticks every night. The officers also made abusive comments about Mohammed's caste. The officers also kept Mohammed in a constant state of hunger and thirst during his detention.

On 7 March 2007, the police officers filed a false theft case against Mohammed.

On 9 March 2007, Mohammed paid SI Likhma Ram and SI Aatma Ram Rs. 10,000 for his release. The officers threatened serious consequences if Mohammed spoke about his detention.

On 11 March 2007, doctors at the Amrit Kaur Hospital in Beawar, including Dr. Hemnant Chauhan, refused to treat Mohammed because he was a suspect in the false theft case and because Mohammed explained that he had received his injuries from the police.

As a result of his detention at the Beawar PS, Mohammed is unable to move his left hand.

On 10 September 2007, Alwar Gate PS Head Constable Vijai Singh Rawath and three to four other police officers went to Khan's shop demanding a bribe of Rs. 500. Khan refused to pay. Head Constable Singh was angered, and said he would give Khan a lesson after he received bribes from other shop owners. Head Constable Singh returned and arrested Khan and took him to the Alwar Gate PS. Khan was jailed with another shop owner who had refused to make a similar bribe.

At the Alwar Gate PS, Khan was slapped and beaten by police officers. He sustained injuries to his back. Head Constable Singh beat Khan with a belt. Head Constable Singh also threatened to lock up Khan for life if he refused payments in the future.

On allegations that Liyakat Khan and Sultan Khan demanded money from Kishan Hariman for liquor and, upon his refusal, beat him up, police went to victims' house at 1.30am on 19 October 2007. Kotwali SI Jitendra Singh, POs Om Parkash, Gautam, Balwant Singh and 8 to 10 unidentified POs raided victims' house and beat up Liyakat and Sultan when they were sleeping. The POs took Liyakat and Sultan to the PS, where they were stripped naked and severely beaten all night with a lathi and a belt, causing swelling all over their bodies.

The incident outraged the residents of Laikam Mohalla. On 20 October 2007, the entire Mohalla gathered in front of the collectorate. They accused the policemen of treating the victims inhumanly and demanded action be taken against the offending POs.

Between August 2, 2007 and August 6, 2007, Sabeer's father was kept in the Sardar PS and the Nagauri PS.

On 6 August, 2007, the police caught Nasir and beat him with a stick until he became unconscious.

### Case Details:

On 21 October 2007, Balser PS police officers arrested victim Ramchandra, age 36. The police officers took Ramchandra to the Balser PS, and beat him in the jeep on the way there.

At the Balser PS, the police officers, including SHO Achaldan Ratnu, hung Ramchandra upside down and beat him with belts and lathis. He was also not allowed to sleep for two nights. As a result of this treatment, Ramchandra cannot walk properly.
